

In-Person PEP Courses for February, March and April 2020 Exams

In-Person PEP Complete course for **April 2020 Exams** starts on Saturday, September 14, 2019 and ends on Saturday, April 18, 2020.

PEP Courses have 27 Teaching Sessions at 4 hours per session.



Exam Preparation: PEP Drills

These are drills done under examination conditions with PEP practice questions. PEP Drills are for persons who have completed one of our PEP complete courses and want additional help in preparing for the February, March and April 2020 Exams. For each session, exams are completed by the students and marked by teachers. The PEP Drills start on Sunday, January 12, 2020 and ends on Sunday, April 19, 2020.


Students enrolled in a **Complete Course** may attend **PEP Drills**, an intense 14 week **Exam Preparation course** or prepare for exams by themselves.

Important Course Notes

- Course Material fees are not refundable.
- Tuition fees are not refundable except when a course is cancelled by Maths Unlimited SuperCourses.
- A student is liable to pay for the total duration of the course including periods of absence.
- Classes can be cancelled, merged or class times changed with short notice.
- Classes may run through traditional school holidays and public holidays due to natural disasters or any other unforeseen circumstances.
- To start a class, the first agreed payment must be made.
